Established in July 2009, Kids First is a non-profit, community-based organization that is driven by a team of volunteers who include Island County foster & adoptive parents, grandparents, artisans, youth advocates, small business owners, social workers, adult adoptees, military veterans, retired educators, & compassionate others.

The Kids First Team aims to promote partnerships throughout the entire community to help children in foster care enjoy normal childhood opportunities. Opportunities like:

- Music Lessons
- Xtra-Curricular Activities

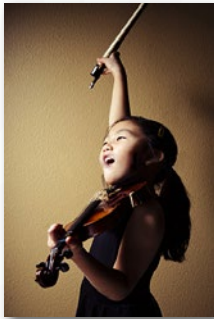
## How Kids First Works

When a child has a need or an aspiration to participate in an educational, vocational, or recreational opportunity and child welfare funds run short, the child's social worker, parents, or CASA submits a request for support to Kids First.

The Kids First Team collaborates with Partners to pool resources, and to generate matching funds, scholarships and even fee waivers. Partnerships are built. Children are linked with opportunity!

Requests for Kids First support might include help with:

- Basic Clothing & Shoes
- Prom Dresses & Tuxedo Rentals
- Specialized Vision or Hearing Aids
- Backpacks & School Supplies
- Sports Fees, Lessons & Gear
- Summer Camp Fees
- Costs of Travel to Visit Siblings
- Graduation Events



## Who Are the Children in Foster Care?

Children in foster care are regular kids—but life has been especially hard on them. They have endured maltreatment and they are in foster care to be protected from further harm. Children remain in foster care while their parents access resources that help them provide safe, stable, nurturing home environments.
